Cargill and District Community Fund Entranceway for “Community”

Cargill, ON, October 3, 2019 - Cargill and District Community Fund (CDCF) are excited to share some good **NEWS**. The current balance owing on the entranceway project is **\$131,676**.

Over three years ago, the need became apparent to address energy inefficiency and accessibility issues. A decision was made to replace the outdated portion of the Cargill Community Centre with a newly constructed addition, consisting of an expanded accessible entranceway, larger meeting room, orderly cloak room, and barrier-free washrooms to create a more useful and energy efficient space. The new entranceway opened on June 20, 2019.

The project cost was \$810,000 with the Municipality of Brockton committed to finance 40% of this project. The CDCF, a committee of volunteers, has been working on financing the remaining \$486,000. Financial support through donations, fundraisers, grants, and reserve funds has realized \$354,058 to date.

The committee is continuing with its public campaign to raise the remaining \$131,676. To the individuals and companies who have already generously contributed to this project, we extend our sincere gratitude.
